
Disclaimer


Controlled Substance Rx/Year








2018 Prescriptions per Quarter








2018 Prescriptions by Drug Schedule







2018 Patient Demographic Environment








2018 Payment Type of Prescriptions








2018 New vs. Refill Prescriptions







2018 % Prescriptions > 90 MME vs. All




Opioid vs. Non-Opioid Prescriptions








Opioid Prescriptions per Year








Benzodiazepine Prescriptions per Year

Drug Generic Name





Users Registered in the CPMRS per Year



CPMRS User Searches per Year






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
CT Controlled Substance Registrations vs. CT Practitioners Writing at least 1 CS Prescription








% of Prescribers Utilizing CPMRS who wrote at least 1 CS Prescription
