<u>Reinstatement Instructions for Individual Real Estate Broker</u> <u>Expired November 20, 2023</u>

• A real estate broker legal entity license may be reinstated provided a completed reinstatement form and all applicable fees are submitted **not later than three years after the date of expiration of the license.**

• Reinstatement of a broker's legal entity license will only be accepted if all applicable fees are paid to bring the license to the current year and required continuing education is complete. Any such reinstated license shall expire on the next succeeding November 30th.

<u>Reinstatement Fees:</u>

- If you worked in Connecticut as real estate broker while your license was expired a total reinstatement fee of \$416.50. must accompany the completed reinstatement application.
- If you <u>did not</u> work in Connecticut as real estate broker while your license was expired a total reinstatement fee of \$<u>379.00</u> must accompany the completed reinstatement application.

Checks/money orders should be made payable to "Treasurer, State of Connecticut."
