

Instructions for Real Estate Reciprocal State Applicants

Requirements:

- <u>Active License</u>: Applicants must have an active license in good standing in the reciprocal state.
- **Examinations**: Applicants must have passed a national uniform real estate licensing examination in the reciprocal state at the time of obtaining their license.
 - ➤ All applicants applying by reciprocity from the following states: Florida, Illinois, Indiana and Ohio <u>or</u> applicants who have *not* taken and passed a real estate licensing examination in a reciprocal state will be required to take the state portion of the Connecticut Real Estate Licensing Examination administered by PSI.
 - > After the application is reviewed and approved by this office, you will receive instructions to register and schedule the examination.
- <u>Certified License History/License Verification Letter</u>: A certified license history/license verification letter generated by the licensing authority in every state in which you currently hold or held a real estate license must accompany your application.
- <u>Salespersons</u>: Your supervising broker must have an active Connecticut broker license.

Fees:

- Salesperson: \$670.00 (\$80 application fee*; \$570 initial license fee; \$20 guaranty fund fee)
- Broker: \$1,270.00 (\$120 application fee*; \$1,130 initial license fee; \$20 guaranty fund fee)

A check or money order in the amount indicated above made payable to **"Treasurer, State of Connecticut"** must accompany the application. Application fees are non-refundable.

* only the application fee is required at the time of application for candidates who are required to take the state portion of the CT Real Estate Licensing Examination.

Broker Business Entities:

• If you intend to do business in CT under the name of a business entity (LLC, Partnership or Corporation, etc.,) you must obtain a broker license in the name of that entity. The New Business Entity Application is available on our website at www.ct.gov/dcp.
