## Reinstatement Instructions for Salespersons - Expired May 31, 2023

- A real estate salesperson's license may be reinstated provided a completed reinstatement form and all applicable fees are submitted not later than three years after the date of expiration of the license.
- Reinstatement of a salesperson's license will only be accepted if all applicable fees are paid to bring the license to the current year. Any reinstated license shall expire on the next succeeding May 31 st.


## Reinstatement Fees:

- If you worked in Connecticut as real estate salesperson while your license was expired a total reinstatement fee of $\$ \mathbf{3 1 7 . 5 0}$ must accompany the completed reinstatement application.
- If you did not work in Connecticut as real estate salesperson while your license was expired a total reinstatement fee of $\mathbf{\$ 2 8 9 . 0 0}$ must accompany the completed reinstatement application.
