## **April 2024 Nip Surcharge Report**

Enclosed are reports received by the Liquor Control Division documenting the amount of nip surcharge money collected by Connecticut wholesalers pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 22a-224b. That statute directs Connecticut wholesalers to submit their reports to Liquor Control and the Department of Revenue Services. Liquor Control is not involved in collecting the data, auditing the data, sending checks to municipalities, nor monitoring how municipalities spend the money.
