MEMORANDUM OF DECISION

On April 19, 2018, after due notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing on the charge of failing to obtain the required fire marshal approval form, in violation of Section 30-39(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 30-6-A3 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. Despite proper notice, the Respondent failed to appear.

Jack Suchy, Liquor Control Director, testified that Cilantro Café filed a 2017 renewal application for its café liquor permit, without the required fire marshal approval form. Despite attempts to contact Cilantro Café regarding the outstanding fire marshal approval form, including a letter sent last October to the premise, as of today's hearing there still is no compliance.

Attorney Anderson stated based upon the circumstance of this case; the Commission may revoke the café liquor permit for Cilantro Cafe.

Based upon the testimony and evidence presented at the hearing, the Department of Consumer Protection hereby revokes the café liquor permit for Cilantro Café.
