On September 8, 2011, after due and proper notice, the Department of Consumer Protection, Liquor Control Commission, held a formal administrative hearing. The following charges are alleged against the Respondent. It is alleged that on May 20, 2011, the Respondent violated: (1) Sec. 30-22(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, (2) Sec. 30-22(f) of the Connecticut General Statutes, (3) Sec. 30-6-A24(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies; (4) Sec. 30-53 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and (5) Sec. 30-6-B25a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. Despite proper notice, the respondent did not appear. On September 21, 2011, the department granted the respondent's request that the hearing be reopened. The reopened hearing was held on October 20, 2011, and the respondent appeared and testified. The record was left open at the conclusion of the hearing for the submission of additional evidence relating to the menu offered at this restaurant premises.

Based upon the testimony and documents submitted at the hearing, and the posthearing submission, the charges are dismissed based upon a lack of substantial evidence. Administrative findings must be based upon substantial evidence. <u>Nelseco Navigation</u> <u>Company v. Department of Liquor Control</u>, 34 Conn. App. 352, 354, 641 A.2d 827 (1994).
