1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN.

Board Chairman Mr. Edward J. Fusco called the meeting to order at 9:32 AM.

2. REVIEW OF DRAFT OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: <u>SEPTEMBER 21, 2018</u>

The Board reviewed and voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the <u>September 21, 2018</u> Board Meeting as submitted. (Von Dassel, Wisniewski)

4. DCP INVESTIGATION DIVISION:

A) Board to review complaint status report when provided.

A current complaint status report was not provided by the DCP Investigations Division. Pamela Brown spoke briefly about the online complaint process.

<u>A) Continued discussion – Proposed draft regulations - DCP Legal Division to provide update regarding proposed draft regulations pertaining to pre-glazed or preassembled.</u>

An update was not provided by the DCP Legal Division.

6. NEW BUSINESS:

(A) Discussion concerning the current apprenticeship training program for flat glass work

Larry Satchell, Kevin McMahon, and Joe Fazzino were present for a discussion with the Board regarding the curriculum of related instruction for flat glass (FG-2) apprentices. It was noted that the current curriculum is outdated and needs to be revamped, as well as the PSI examination content. Richard Hurlburt clarified that the procedure to change the curriculum and exam would be to submit the old curriculum outline, the new curriculum outline, and a summary of the differences between the two, to Todd Berch, Dept. of Labor and Richard Hurlburt, Dept. of Consumer Protection. Once it is approved, the new curriculum can be implemented for apprentices, and a workshop would be set up with PSI to update the exam content.

(B) Discussion concerning Advanced Driver Assistance Systems calibration

John Wisniewski proposed that the Department of Labor consider adjusting the current curriculum for auto glass apprentices (AG-2) to include the area of Advanced Driver Assistance Systems calibration, as ADAS systems are becoming popular. For vehicles with this feature, anytime a new windshield is installed, the camera must be calibrated

to ensure functionality. The Board reviewed documentation from AGRSS (American National Standard Automotive Glass Replacement Safety Standard) and manufacturers' literature regarding these systems.

(C) PSI Pass/Fail Report - FG-2 - 01/01/2018 to 09/22/2018

The Board requested that Richard Hurlburt provide additional information regarding the exam scores included in this report at the next meeting.
