This modification shall take effect immediately and remain in effect for the duration of the public health and civil preparedness emergency.

The Board recommends that Executive Order No. 9M be modified to extend the deadlines for plumbers to complete their continuing education requirements from 2020 through any authorized means. This modification shall take effect immediately and remain in effect for the duration of the public health and civil preparedness emergency.
