19. Review of Correspondence:

(A) <u>Evaluation Forms For Continuing Education Course</u>; for the Board's review and information. The Board acknowledged this information and reviewed the forms in general.

20. Old Business:

(A) <u>Resubmission of the 2012 Continuing Education Package from National Code Seminars</u>; for the Board's discussion and reconsideration.

Mr. Hurlburt noted that the Commissioner has asked the Board to reconsider this application and be more proactive on this submission based upon the changes the applicant made per the Board's first review. Mr. Hurlburt noted that there is no statutory deadline for application submissions. Mr. Vallieres acknowledged that the deadline date is a Board policy.

Mr. Vallieres noted that the Boards original review comments stated that the application does not comply with the requirements because the curriculum submitted contained no material relative to what the Board was looking for in their curriculum outline. Mr. Bish stated that the applicant's submission contained a course that did not cover material from 2008 through 2011 but instead submitted more of a general course.

Ms. Gavin-Kuhn stated that the Board saw that his submission was more national in focus and had not taken the time to incorporate Connecticut's specific changes such as the 2008 and 2011 Building Code requirements and that the CEU requisite was now four years and not seven years any longer. Mr. Vallieres cited the Boards <u>approved</u> December 9, 2011 minutes which states that "continuing education providers that were initially not approved by the Board <u>will not be allowed</u> to resubmit their course offerings for reconsideration."

After more discussion the Board concluded that the application still remains incomplete and that the curriculum requirements are available on line and that it is the applicant's responsibility to comply with the same. As such, the Board voted, again, to uphold their original decision and not approve National Code Seminars application. (Soter/Gavin-Kuhn)

(B) Mr. Vallieres reported to the Board that the Freedom of Information request presented to the Board at their last meeting was e-mailed to the Commissioner by him.

He also noted that that the Department's Legal department Head Ms. Elisa Nahas is handling this request. FOI requests are handled by the Department and not the Board. Further Mr. Vallieres asked that the Commissioner to copy him on all responses sent to the person who made the initial request.

21. New Business:

(A) Mr. Hurlburt presented the Board with a draft of a Sign License Apprenticeship Program. He noted that this apprenticeship program is being handled by the Department in the interim until the Department of Labor finalizes a program. Mr. Hurlburt noted that applicants will be registered with the Department using this outline as a guideline so that they may eventually get a C-8 license. Applicants will have to spend two years as registered apprentice and also take school related instruction. This outline was developed by Mr. Hurlburt in conjunction with the Sign Industry in order to get the applicants on the right road so to speak.

Mr. Vallieres stated that he has also spoken with a representative of the sign industry. Further, the Board wants the apprentices to get a full understanding of all the technical details of the various signs. The Board generally approved this outline as a work in progress and also suggested that the outline contain the words "Connecticut Registered Apprentice".

Mr. Vallieres spoke with Run Hassmann and noted that the sign providers typically provide their continuing education course offering one day usually in September. They missed the deadline date for their submission this year. Mr. Vallieres suggested the possibility of the sign CE provider adding his curriculum to that of an approved provider for an E Class license. The Board agreed that this can be done for this year in light of the pending development of the sign CEU curriculum.

(B) Mr. Vallieres informed the Board that he received and e-mail from Bob Nuzzi State Electrical Inspector noting that he had been told by the Director of United Illuminating that a CEU Instructor at a class held in Hamden Connecticut told electricians that they are not allowed to do "Cut and Reconnects" any longer. Mr. Nuzzi stated that calls from inspectors and electricians have been generated by this statement and it is of great concern to both UI and CL & P. Mr. Nuzzi asked the Board to please look into this matter.

Mr. Vallieres in turn e-mailed Peter Childree and informed him of this situation. He stressed the importance that the delivery of information to all classes must be accurate and in accordance with the program that was outlined and approved by the Electrical Work Examining Board. Incorrect, incomplete and or confusing information is not acceptable to our program and must cease immediately.

He also stated that it was his understanding that an issue does exist with an OSHA inspection on a contractor performing a service change, at which time the contractor was cited, however it is also his understanding that this case/issue has been forwarded to OSHA in Washington for a formal interpretation, and that the Board is <u>presently awaiting their review and comment.</u> When this developed the Utility Companies took immediate action and have been involved with OSHA regarding their "Cut and Reconnect" policy.

He further stated that the "Cut and Reconnect" policy still exists with each individual Utility Company that allows such, and each electrical contractor is required to contact the particular Utility Company for the location where the work is proposed to be performed and follow the policy of that Utility Company. Contractors should always check with the local Utility for any and all new information that may affect the proposed work to be performed.

Mr. Vallieres told Mr. Childree that since issues have risen as a result of information given at one of his classes, he is requesting that he forward to each attendee a written statement of correction regarding this issue, and forward to Mr. Vallieres a copy of such correspondence along with a list of all attendees that took that class for the Board's records.
