#### 1. Residential Fire Protection Sprinkler Systems

The Board continued to discuss the ongoing issue of licenses required to install these multipurpose piping sprinkler systems.

The Board expressed concern over the fact that the Plumbing Board's minutes have included this topic and stated recently that Chairperson Chuck Appleby intends to meet with the Commissioner of DCP.

Licensing currently requires an F-1 with F-2 employees for the sprinkler portion. There are several potential problems to be considered with these multi-purpose systems regarding improper installation and maintenance if not performed by a properly qualified person.
