OLD BUSINESS:

1. Residential fire sprinkler systems

- Follow up on e-mail from Bob Hanbury to Bill Ethier, CAE, CEO & General Counsel,
 Home Builders & Remodelers Association of CT, October 26, 2015 regarding liability
 At the November meeting, a discussion took place as to whether the facts stated in this
 letter regarding fire-related deaths in Connecticut since the 1980's are accurate. The
 Board agreed that this information should be verified with the State Fire Marshal's Office
 before they move forward with any correspondence on this topic.
- Connecticut Fire Sprinkler Coalition live burn demonstration and educational forum, West Haven, CT, December 1, 2015
 David Waskowicz and Anthony Moscato attended this event and reported back to the Board.
- State Building Inspectors Office Adoption of codes for residential fire sprinklers
 Edward Peznowski reported that he has spoken with the State Building Inspector's
 Office and that they are in favor of passing the residential fire sprinkler law into the
 codes, however, they are waiting for the Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board

and the Fire Protection Board to come to an agreement as to what license will be required to do this work. After further discussion, several board members noted that that the licensing laws are already in place and clear, therefore, there is no need to clarify. A multipurpose sprinkler and plumbing piping system must be installed by a licensed contractor that holds both types P-1 and an F-1 licenses and with employees that hold both types P-2 and F-2 journeyperson licenses.

1. Resignation of Edward Peznowski, Public Member

Edward Peznowski announced that he will be resigning from the Board as of today's meeting. The Board thanked him for his dedication and service to the Board.
