OLD BUSINESS:

1. Residential fire sprinkler systems

David LaFond, NFSA, was present and submitted two documents. These documents were added to the agenda by board vote and a review and discussion took place:

 Media Advisory on a Live Life Saving Fire Safety Demonstration taking place on May 2, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. in the Home Depot parking lot, 503 New Park Avenue, West Hartford, CT.

The Board discussed the effectiveness of side-by-side demonstrations such as this one to inform the public of how fast fire spreads and the benefits of having a fire sprinkler in the home.

 Letter addressed to Senator Timothy Larson and Representative Stephen Dargan, Co-chairs of the Public Safety Committee, from David LaFond, NFSA, dated April 13, 2015 regarding the installation of automatic fire sprinklers in new residential construction in Connecticut, including a brief on this topic issued by the Network for Public Health Law.

The Board, along with Mr. LaFond, reviewed this letter and attached brief, and reiterated their concerns for public safety if Connecticut does not adopt the code change which requires the installation of fire sprinklers in all new one and two family homes. In addition, the use of lightweight construction materials in new

homes has become more prevalent, despite the fact that these materials cause fires to burn faster and places residents and first responders in even more danger in the event of a fire.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Connecticut Statute Section 20-334a, Types of Licenses; for the Board's information

The Board reviewed Statute Section 20-334a and a discussion ensued regarding recent statutes changes relating to lapsed licenses and the reinstatement process. The Board expressed their concern over the fact that they were not informed of recent changes in the statutes and regulations pertaining to the Fire Protection Board.

The Board voted unanimously to request that the Department provide the Board in writing with any changes or updates in the statutes and regulations pertaining to the Fire Protection Board going forward.

2. The following late-arriving applications were added to the agenda by board vote:

Michael McKelvie, Northbridge, MA – (F-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Approved The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Mckelvie's (F-2) application.

William Seward, Purdys, NY – (F-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Seward's (F-2) application due to lack of original, notarized employer letter stating dates and duties employment.

Michael Donovan, Windsor Locks, CT – (F-2) Unlimited Contractor – Approved Mr. Donovan's (F-1) application was denied on 3/19/15 by the Board due to lack of a current Connecticut (F-2) license. Mr. Donovan appeared today for reconsideration of his application. After discussion with the Board, Mr. Donovan chose to amend the category of license sought to the (F-2) license. The Board voted unanimously to approve the (F-2) application.
