The Board reviewed the draft minutes from the March 15, 2018 Fire Protection Sprinkler Systems Work Examining Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve as written.

MOTION TO AMEND AGENDA TO ADD THE APPEARANCE OF PAMELA BROWN, DIRECTOR OF INVESTIGATIONS UNIT:

Pamela Brown, newly hired as Director of Investigations, introduced herself to the Board. The Board briefly informed Pamela of their concerns regarding violations taking place in the fire protection trade.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Multipurpose Residential Fire Sprinkler Systems
 - Update on drafting of related instruction requirements for proposed license types F7/F8 (Note: Now license types F5/F6) by David Waskowicz and Robert Hollis

David Waskowicz reported that he and Robert Hollis met with DCP Commissioner Michelle Seagull, Todd Berch, Department of Labor, and other DCP staff on April 2, 2018 to discuss the F7/F8 (Now F5/F/6) proposed license category and curriculum. The drafting of the curriculum is still in progress and is moving forward.

A memo from Home Builders and Remodelers Association of Connecticut, Inc. (HBRA) dated May 8, 2018 regarding the association's opposition to the proposed new State Building Code and the requirement to install fire sprinklers in all new townhomes was distributed and noted by the Board. This proposed code change is currently in regulation review.

Kevin Griffith distributed a document containing a list of the members of the regulation review committee, their opinion, and their contact information. William Abbott, Office of the State Fire Marshal, stated that his Office has reached out to AFSA to gather support on this issue and Board members are urged to contact review committee members before the vote, which is scheduled for May 22, 2018.

2. Connecticut General Statutes Section 20-330; Definition of "Fire Protection Sprinkler Systems Work"

Proposed Bill No. 5320 – An Act Concerning Occupational Licensing And Building Trades and Contractor Debarment included the addition of the terms "inspection and testing" to the definition of fire sprinkler systems work. David Waskowicz informed the Board that the bill has been withdrawn.
