OLD BUSINESS:

1. Substitute House Bill No. 6100 - Public Act 21-37 - An Act Concerning Department of Consumer Protection Licensing and Enforcement, Antitrust Issues, and the Palliative Use of Marijuana and Revisions to the Liquor Control Act

The Board has expressed their concern regarding changes to Connecticut General Statutes, Chapter 393 requiring written contracts meeting certain specifications for work on private residential property by licensed tradespersons and the right to cancel timeframe prior to performing work.

The DCP Legal Division and Legislative Program Director Leslie O'Brien are in the process of addressing the matter regarding the changes in language that passed within Public Act 21-37 relating to contract requirements. Occupational licensing boards will be notified and updated as to the progress of making changes.

2. Continued review of out of state occupational trade licenses for determination of equivalency to Connecticut occupational trade licenses

A. At the September 16, 2021 Application Review Working Group Meeting, it was determined that the following license types are equivalent:
