OLD BUSINESS:

1. Substitute House Bill No. 6100 - Public Act 21-37 - An Act Concerning Department of Consumer Protection Licensing and Enforcement, Antitrust Issues, and the Palliative Use of Marijuana and Revisions to the Liquor Control Act

The Board has expressed their concern regarding changes to Connecticut General Statutes, Chapter 393 requiring written contracts meeting certain specifications for work on private residential property by licensed tradespersons and the right to cancel timeframe prior to performing work.

DCP has revised the language in this bill and it is being addressed in the current Legislation Session. Board Member Cameron Champlin will continue to monitor this situation on behalf of the Board.
