# **APPEARING IN PERSON FOR APPEAL:**

### Scott Ezold, East Haddam, CT - (D-2) Limited Journeyperson - Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Ezold's (D-2) application due to lack of apprenticeship completion.

# Alex Littman, Bridgewater, MA – (S-2) Unlimited Contractor – Approved with change in category

Mr. Littman, after discussion with the Board, chose to amend the category of the license sought from an (S-1) to an (S-2). The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Littman's (S-2) application. The Board further ruled that, upon passage of the (S-2) examination, the two-year requirement is waived and he may immediately take the (S-1) examination without further Board approval.

### Victor Luciano, Waterbury, CT – (D-2) Limited Journeyperson – Conditional approval
