APPEARING IN PERSON FOR APPEAL:

Marjan Gjuraj, Shelton, CT – (S-1) Unlimited Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Gjuraj's application due to lack of the required (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years, lack of apprenticeship completion, and lack of required hours of related instruction.

David Viera, Stamford, CT - (S-2) Unlimited Journeyperson - Approved for D-2

Mr. Viera, after discussion with the Board, chose to amend the category of license sought from an (S-2) to a (D-2). The Board then voted to approve Mr. Viera's (D-2) application.
