(B) Home Inspector License application – Todd David LeSiege, Huntington, MA

The Board reviewed this application and determined that the applicant has two options to continue to apply for this license. One option is to obtain a Massachusetts license and then apply to Connecticut by reciprocity; the other is to apply for equivalent experience and training, which includes completion of a pre-licensure course and proof of 100 home inspections.

(C) Home Inspector Intern Supervision

The Board drafted a notice to send to supervisors of home inspector interns to clarify their responsibilities as a supervisor. This notice was reviewed and revised by the DCP Legal Division prior to today's meeting. The revised document entitled <u>Home Inspector</u> Intern Supervision, as well as a <u>Home Inspection Disclosure Form</u> was reviewed by the

Board at today's meeting. The Board determined that they will contact Cynthia Fernandez, DCP Legal Division with their suggestions for changes or additional language.
