HEARINGS:

1. RANDAZZO, SEBASTIAN D. – LIP.14309

Windham Wine & Spirits, Store, Willimantic, CT

Remove from hearings. Prior to compliance meeting, the matter was settled by permittee agreeing to an offer in compromise in lieu of hearing. He will accept a \$500 fine and 1 day suspension on October 2, 2017 for an incident involving a sale to minor on July 12, 2017.
