DISCUSSION OF SOLAR THERMAL INITIATIVES

The Board discussed solar thermal certification for individuals seeking to obtain a solar thermal (ST-1 / ST-2) license in CT, which are under the jurisdiction of the Heating, Piping, Cooling and Sheet Metal Board.

Mr. Barrieau reported that a solar thermal subcommittee is in place to work on recommending a 24-hour solar thermal certification course. The intent is to create a solar thermal curriculum course outline suited for qualified heating and plumbing license holders seeking to do solar thermal work in CT, with a concentrated effort on solar thermal technology.

Once the Solar Thermal certification course curriculum outline is finalized by the Solar Thermal Sub-Committee, the Heating Board will receive it for their approval at their next meeting scheduled for April 7, 2010.

The solar thermal certification course curriculum outline will be the required format for providers offering the solar thermal certification course.
