MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

The Board voted unanimously to approve minutes of the April 26, 2012 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting.

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Ferro's application due to lack of a required (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years.

WELL PERMIT REQUEST

Joe Asklar – Mr. Asklar appeared before the Board at their 3/29/12 meeting to request a well permit for the construction of a gravel packed well at 356 N. Main Street, Marlborough, CT. After further discussion and input on this matter, the Board voted unanimously to table their decision, contingent upon receipt and review of the following information:

- 1. A letter from the Town of Marlborough, CT verifying the owner of the property located at 356 N. Main Street, Marlborough, CT.
- 2. The specific diagram of the well to be constructed at 356 N. Main Street, Marlborough, CT.
- 3. Name of the individual or individuals constructing the well in addition to any well drilling license and/or registration held by such individual or individuals constructing the well at 356 N. Main Street, Marlborough, CT.
- 4. A letter from both the Town of Marlborough and Chatham Health concerning the approval of the location of the well to be constructed at 356 N. Main Street, Marlborough, CT.

After further review of correspondence received, discussion and input on this matter at today's meeting, the Board unanimously concluded their lack of jurisdiction to issue a well permit due to lack of a required CT Well Drilling Contractor license to permit the issuance of a well drilling permit.
