The Plumbing and Piping Work Board shall consist of twelve members who shall be residents of this state, one of whom shall be a general contractor or an unlimited contractor licensed for such occupations under this chapter, two of whom shall be unlimited contractors licensed for such occupations under this chapter, neither of whom at the time of appointment shall be a member or an employee of a member of a trade union or a party or an employee of a party to a contract with a trade union, one of whom shall be a well drilling contractor licensed pursuant to section 25-129, four of whom shall be unlimited journeymen licensed for such occupations under this chapter, who at the time of appointment shall be members of a trade union, and four of whom shall be public members.

# **APPLICANTS APPEARING IN PERSON**

James A. Hart, Southbury CT – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor – Approved (P-2) Mr. Hart appeared to appeal the Board's 10/11/2012 denial ruling due to lack of on the job training and 720 hours of school related instruction as required.

The Board voted to deny the P-1 request and, with the applicant's request, by a vote of 3-2 approved the applicant for the P-2 examination. The Board ruled that once the (P-2) exam has been passed and any missing P-2 courses have been completed, (to be determined upon review of the State of Rhode Island courses previously taken), Mr. Hart may again apply for the (P-1) license exam.

Norman D. LaMere, Jr., New Hartford CT – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor - Tabled Mr. LaMere was to appear to appeal the Board's 10/11/2012 denial ruling due to a lack of a (P-2) license for a minimum of two years as required. Mr. LaMere holds active (S-1) and (STC-1) licenses, and has held his (P-2) license since 3/12/2012.

Applicant did not appear; the Board tabled the application.

Thomas R. Bailey, Cheshire CT – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson - Denied Mr. Bailey attached no documentation to his application; there is no evidence of any past application.

Board denied; applicant must complete apprenticeship.

Peter J. Giro, New Fairfield CT – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor - Denied Mr. Giro provides a notarized statement from his past out of state employer as to dates and duties of employment, but has not provided any evidence of school related instruction.

Board denied; applicant must complete required apprenticeship and apply for P-2 first.
