MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

The draft minutes of September 12, 2013 were accepted by the Board as written.

APPEARING IN PERSON TO SEEK GUIDANCE:

Mr. Peguero was unable to attend this meeting.

APPLICATIONS:

Bradford Piesco, West Bridgewater, MA – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor – Denied

The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Piesco's application due to lack of a required (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson license for a minimum of two years.

APPLICATIONS ADDED TO AGENDA BY BOARD VOTE:

Dennis Cogley, Killingworth, CT – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted to deny Mr. Cogley's application due to lack of proof of amount of required registered on-the-job training hours. Chairperson Charles Appleby, Sr. abstained from voting.

Joseph Hansen, Newtown, CT – (J-2) Limited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Hansen's application due to lack of proof of the required hours of school-related instruction for the (J-2) license type.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Achieving proper enforcement for occupational trade licenses

Frank DaCato reported on the most recent meeting regarding enforcement, which was held at the L.O.B. and is an independent, multi-trade, union and non-union group of concerned persons. Those in attendance discussed their concerns and suggested possible changes within DCP that may lead to more effective enforcement. Nothing was finalized; however, it was a very positive and productive meeting. The next meeting will be held at the L.O.B. on November 6, 2013 at 10:00 a.m., at which these ideas will be explored further.

2. Residential sprinkler system licensing requirements

- Installation of water mist fire protection systems, which are not considered fire sprinkler systems
- 2013 NFPA 13: Installation of sprinkler systems 4-day seminar

- Legislative proposal titled, "Residential Multipurpose Plumbing and Fire Sprinkler Systems Draft Legislation"
- Reliable Model MP LL 1" Residential Riser

The Board will discuss this topic further at the November 7, 2013 meeting. In particular, the legislative proposal titled, "Residential Multipurpose Plumbing and Fire Sprinkler Systems Draft Legislation" will be further explored.

3. Notice of Tentative Decision for General Permit for the Discharge of Low Flow Water Treatment Wastewater

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Continuing Education Changes 2014 - 2015

Board member Frank DaCato presented a document in draft form outlining the 2014-15 CEU Plumbing Section Changes for the Board's review. Due to the large number of code changes coming up in 2015, the upcoming continuing education cycle will be challenging, therefore, the Board discussed various ways in which to address these changes in order to educate licensees appropriately and thoroughly.

The Board voted unanimously to approve the following changes for 2014-2015 continuing education cycle for P-1 and P-2 license holders:

- 1) Increase the hours required for journeyperson license holders from 5 to 7 hours.
- 2) The course content for P-1 and P-2 classes shall be based on 2012 Plumbing and IRC Codes changes only.
- 3) 2012 Code Books are mandatory. Each student must either bring a book or purchase one from the facilitator.

Frank DaCato will submit the final version of this document on the November 7 meeting. Also, a curriculum outline must be prepared and approved by the Commissioner of DCP.

2. OSHA requirements

Board member Frank DaCato reported on recent legislative changes regarding OSHA requirements for plumbing and electrical license holders. Specifically, these licensees are only required to have four hours of classroom training every five years to keep their OSHA requirements current.

The Board reviewed the current complaint status report submitted by Trade Practices Division and noted that limited enforcement was shown.
