APPEARING IN PERSON TO APPEAL:

Timothy Davison, Raymond, ME – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – TabledMr. Davison appeared to appeal the Board's denial of November 13, 2014. The
Board voted unanimously to table this application until the required 720 hours of
related instruction is completed. The Board further ruled that proof of completion of
related instruction, along with a new application, should be sent to DCP for approval.

APPEAL:

Rashaad Cochran, Stamford, CT – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson - Approved The Board voted unanimously to approve Mr. Cochran's (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson application.

APPLICATIONS ADDED TO AGENDA BY BOARD VOTE:

Charles Tilton, Methuen, MA – (P-2) Unlimited Journeyperson – Denied The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Tilton's (P-2) application due to lack of related instruction and on the job training.

Junor Carter, Bronx, NY – (P-1) Unlimited Contractor – Denied
The Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Carter's (P-1) application due to lack of a (P-2) license for the required two years.

DISCUSSION ON DENIAL OF ZACHARY CARR:

Board Member Carl Schaefer requested that the board reconsider the November 13, 2014 denial of Zachary Carr's (P-2) application. The Board reviewed the application and related documents and discussion ensued regarding Mr. Carr's credentials. A motion was made and seconded to allow Mr. Carr to sit for the P-2 examination. The motion was denied on a 5 to 2 vote, with one member not voting.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Residential sprinkler system licensing requirements

Chairperson Charles Appleby reported that the next Connecticut Fire Sprinkler Coalition meeting will take place on Tuesday, December 16 at 10:00 a.m. at the Anna V. Molloy School in New Haven.

2. Public Act 14-199, Substitute Senate Bill No. 235 - An Act Concerning Revisions to the Transportation Statutes.

3. State of Connecticut Regulation of the Department of Consumer Protection Concerning Aeration Piping System Work

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Licensing for horizontal well drilling

Board Member George Sima brought up concerns over horizontal and directional well drilling methods. After discussion on this matter, Board members present voted unanimously to support a change in the current well drilling regulations to include licensure for persons who perform horizontal and directional drilling. DCP Legislative Liaison, Gary Berner, will be informed of this proposal.

4. Consumer safety issues

A discussion took place regarding the use of PVC pipe for gas burner venting and related safety concerns, and the trend across the country toward the the use of polypropylene pipe as an alternate. The Board also discussed the issue of venting pipes being too close to the ground and creating a potential dangerous situation when snow is not removed properly by the homeowner. Chairperson Charles Appleby will contact the appropriate state agencies to initiate a press release to the public regarding these issues.
