#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### 1. Residential multipurpose fire sprinkler systems

 At the September meeting, the Board voted unanimously to table the topic of multipurpose residential fire sprinkler systems until such time that Richard M. Hurlburt, Director contacts the State of Ct., Office of the State Building Inspector, for clarification on whether or not residential multipurpose fire sprinkler systems can be installed and approved by the local authority.

The Board reviewed a letter from Daniel Tierney, Deputy State Building Inspector dated September 14, 2016 in response to the request for clarification on this topic by Richard Hurlburt.

## 2. DOL apprenticeship requirements

At the September meeting, the Board requested clarification from Larry Satchell regarding a state law or policy of the Department of Labor addressing the ability for a business owner to become a registered apprentice. It is the Board's understanding that a business owner *cannot* be a registered as an apprentice.

Larry Satchell submitted an Interoffice Memorandum from Heidi Lane, Principal Attorney, Department of Labor, dated October 11, 2016 regarding DOL's policy that a contractor/owner may not be an apprentice in a different trade. The Board reviewed this document and a discussion took place regarding the interpretation of the language contained within the document. The Board requested that DCP contact Attorney Raul Rodriguez, Assistant Attorney General and invite him to the next meeting for further clarification.

#### 3. OSHA requirements

Discussion took place regarding OSHA requirements for occupational trade licensees. The understanding is that, for the plumbing and electrical licenses, a 4 hour refresher course every 5 years is required, versus the full 10 hour refresher the other trades are required to complete. Those present were not clear as to what legislation or statute exists that addresses this requirement. It would be helpful to have this clarified before the Board begins the drafting of the 2017 curriculum, which will take place in February of 2017.
