MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

The Board reviewed the draft minutes of the April 12, 2018 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meetings and approved as written.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Proposed Well Drilling and Geothermal Systems Regulations
 - Continued discussion on adding variances or well locations to proposed regulations

Charles Appleby reported that representatives from DPH (Department of Public Health) have been invited to today's meeting for further discussion. Charles Appleby informed the Board that DCP's Legislative Liaison will be working with DPH's Legislative Liaison going forward to discuss proposed changes to well drilling regulations, and that he will continue to follow up with both agencies on this matter.

Lawrence Sima, Ct. Water Well Association, was in attendance to discuss proposed changes to well drilling and geothermal regulations. The Board reviewed the current regulations, as well as the previously drafted proposed regulations dated September 2013.

The Board discussed additional changes to proposed regulations, including language pertaining to minimum separation distances between the location of a water supply well and any source of pollution, such as a septic system.

The Board will propose regulations according to the discussion today. Board members will have the opportunity to review and bring any comments or suggestions to the August 9, 2018 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting. Charles Appleby will invite Leslie O'Brien, Legislative Director to attend the August 9, 2018 meeting.

2. Continued discussion on continuing education provider regulations and statutes

It was noted that the State Building Official code updates may not go forward until October 2018, and that these codes may affect continuing education provider regulations and statutes for the next continuing education cycle.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Review of continuing education evaluation forms

After a review of evaluation forms, the Board voted unanimously to allow Charles Appleby to draft a letter to all continuing education providers stating that they must follow the approved curriculum and hours, and that they can not break away from training for any other events, including specialized training unrelated to the curriculum or manufacturer-specific training.

2. Plumbing Credential Counts as of 2006 – P-2 – 2,584 P-1 – 2,906 Plumbing Credential Counts as of 2018 – P-2 – 2,225 P-1 – 2,779

The Board reviewed documents containing the number of credential holders in 2006 and 2018.
