MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS:

The Board reviewed the draft minutes of the June 21, 2018 Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting and voted unanimously to approve with corrections. Melissa Sheffy abstained from voting.

APPLICANT TO APPEAR IN PERSON:

1. Kurt Boehm, Jr., Andover, CT - P-1 Unlimited Contractor application

Kurt Boehm appeared for discussion with the Board regarding his request for a waiver of P-2 Unlimited Journeyperson license for required two year period. Ernie Koch, the contractor of record for his business was also in attendance. After discussion, the Board voted unanimously to deny Mr. Boehm's request for a waiver due to lack of hardship. The Board noted that Mr. Boehm will be eligibile for the P-1 exam as of July, 2019.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Proposed Well Drilling and Geothermal Systems Regulations

The Board reviewed the proposed change to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Section 19-13-B51d – Location, which adds the following language, "The minimum separation distances listed in this section 19-13-B51d may be further reduced with the approval of the Commissioner in consultation with the Department of Public Health."

After discussion regarding well drilling and geothermal systems regulations, it was determined that the Department will schedule a meeting of the Plumbing and Piping Work Examining Board meeting in September to work toward making changes to these regulations. Notice of this meeting will be sent to Leslie O'Brien, DCP Legislative Program Director, Brie Wolf, DPH Legislvative Liaison, DPH staff present today, as well as Maura Esposito, Chesprocott Health District, and Larry Sima, representing the Ct. Water Well Association.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Review of continuing education evaluation forms

2. DCP application process

Standard documents used by the Department to correspond with applicants regarding incomplete or denied applications were reviewed by the Board. Discussion took place regarding the November 16, 2016 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and changes to the application process outlined in the MOU. Charles Appleby noted that occupational trade licensing board chairpersons are meeting with DCP Commissioner Michelle Seagull about the MOU and related topics on Monday, August 20, 2018.

3. Continuing education provider – Construction Education Center

The Board voted unanimously to approve the request by Construction Education Center for the addition of two additional classroom locations: Fairfield University and University of New Haven, Orange campus.
