1. Application Review Working Group – Update to be provided by designated board Member

Charles Appleby reported that Application Review meetings continue to take place monthly, and that there were approximately eight applications for review at the January meeting.

2. Continued education requirement modifications

Discussion took place regarding the modifications that have been put into place through Executive Order 9M, which will expire February 9, 2021. It was noted that there are many licensees that are still looking to attend an online or in person class to meet their requirements. After discussion, the Board voted unanimously to recommend the following:

The Board recommends that Executive Order No. 9M be modified to extend the period during which course providers can continue offering interactive, online courses. This modification shall take effect immediately and remain in effect for the duration of the public health and civil preparedness emergency.

The Board recommends that Executive Order No. 9M be modified to extend the deadlines for plumbers to complete their continuing education requirements from 2020 through any authorized means. This modification shall take effect immediately and remain in effect for the duration of the public health and civil preparedness emergency.

3. Legal Administrative Hearings – Request for representative from AAG's Office

At the November 5, 2020 meeting, the Board requested that they have a representative from the Attorney General's Office attend Legal Administrative Hearings that come before this Board. The Board was advised to contact the Attorney General's Office directly for this request.
