Virtual classroom setting be allowed for pre-licensing

It was moved by Commissioner Ells, Commission Bergquist 2nd, and the motion carried unanimously that Live Virtual will be allowed to be considered as a classroom setting for pre-licensing.

Letter to the Real Estate Commission from Noah Matthews

Mr. Matthews submitted a letter to the board on a matter of concern as to whether an agency in a Commercial listing agreement must disclose to the property owners, if they will be offering a co-broke commission agreement to other brokers.

Acting Chairman Castonguay stated he would need to talk to legal, as he is concerned the Commission cannot get involved with commission agreements. It was tabled to put this matter a future agenda.
