Regulations in process:

- o Permanent 120 hours for CPA Exam- Published in the law journal on December 11, 2007.
- o CPA Exam Fee- Currently at the Attorney General's office; January '08, or February '08 the earliest Attorney Adams expects it to come back.

Director Guay briefed the board on the AICPA's invitation to comment on the CPA Exam:

Director Guay felt the invitation did not fully address the board's issues and concerns. Specifically, the Board feels the best interests of the candidates would best be served with shorter black out periods, or no black out periods. Furthermore, the Board feels, in the least, the months of December and June should be testing months.

Motion made by Michael Weinshel and seconded by Leonard Romaniello to approve the responses in regards to the AICPA's Questionnaire on the CPA Exam. All voted in favor; no votes against and no abstentions.

2. OTHER SETTLEMENTS

2007133-3095 David Gallagher – Practicing without a license.

Mr. Gallagher became a partner at the firm of Capossela and Cohen, LLC in 2005; prior to that he was employed there but not a partner. He failed to reinstate his license at that time. Investigation shows no intent to mislead the Board. He submitted proof of more than 40 hours of acceptable CPE for 2005, 2006, and 2007 and has supplied 40 hours of CPE within the previous 12 months along with back licensing fees for those years. His application for reinstatement in 2008 is pending this settlement request.

Recommend reinstating license in conjunction with a settlement requiring payment of \$1,350 in overdue licensing fees and submission of acceptable CPE for all relevant years.

Motion made by Richard Bond and seconded by Martha Triplett to accept Attorney Adams' recommendation of licensure reinstatement in case# 2007133-3095 (David Gallagher). All voted in favor; no votes against and no abstentions. Michael Weinshel recused himself prior to the discussion and voting of this case.

<u>**2007061-3061 Eugene Esares**</u> – Practicing without a license

Mr. Esares did not hold a license in 2006 and 2007 but did hold a valid firm permit. He applied for reinstatement in November of 2007 with proof of 40 hours of acceptable CPE in the 12 months prior to the application.

Recommend reinstating his license in conjunction with a settlement requiring payment of \$500 fine in addition to back licensing fees (\$900)

Motion made by Michael Weinshel and seconded by Richard Bond to accept Attorney Adams' recommendation of licensure reinstatement in case# 2007061-3061 (Eugene Esares). All voted in favor; no votes against and no abstentions.

Motion made by Richard Bond and seconded by Martha Triplett to adjourn the January 08, 2008 Board Meeting; all voted in favor. The meeting was officially closed at 09:15 A.M.
