The firm underwent, but did not report, a quality review in December of 2006. The reviewer identified the licensure issues. At the same time, the Office of Policy and Management notified the firm and the Board of the performance of municipal audits in 2006 while unlicensed. Mr. Monroe then submitted applications for reinstatement for the firm

and both individuals. An audit of the reported cpe revealed that neither of the individuals could document 40 hours of cpe for the 2006 reporting period.
