# NEW BUSINESS

## 1. Extension for Continuing Professional Education in Light of coronavirus pandemic.

The Board discussed and took into consideration the NASBA recommended deadline of October 31, 2020 noting that NASBA would adjust to what the Board decided. Mr. Niedermeyer wondered if December 31, 2020 would be better in consideration of delays in Federal tax filings and people now working out of the office.

After extensive discussion, the Board voted unanimously to extend the deadline to December 31, 2020. (Niedermeyer/Fox)

## 2. Extension for CPA Examination Sections in Light of coronavirus pandemic

The Board discussed and took into account the test center closings in light of the current national crisis. The date of September 30, 2020 was the date initially discussed by the Board. Mr. Virnelli asked the Board if they should take into account the NASBA recommendations in their decision?

As such, the Board voted unanimously to conform to the NASBA extension dates and criteria for the National Testing due to the Corona Virus. In addition, the Board will also conform to any potential changes to these dates made by NASBA in the future as may be necessary. (Fox/Marien)
