Atty. Steven Schwane

Atty. Schwane provided an update to the proposed legislation. Atty. Schwane stated that the Department of Consumer Protection submitted their legislative package to the governor's office which had eighteen legislative proposals. The governor's office accepted only half of the department's legislative package; where as the engineering package was not accepted.

Atty. Schwane stated that land surveying complaints were dispersed to the volunteers on the CALS list along with the guidelines provided by Curt Smith.

Deputy Commissioner Jerry Farrell addressed the Board regarding the legislative package. Deputy Commissioner Farrell stated that the department submitted about eighteen legislative proposals amongst of which were the engineering legislative proposal. The legislative package is submitted to the Office of Policy and Management (OPM) and the governor's office, and at that point the governor may adopt some of them or none of them. The Department submitted more proposals than are normally submitted by other departments.

Chairman D'Andrea inquired as to which proposals were successful. Deputy Commissioner Farrell stated that the proposals that were successful were the Real Estate Bill which the commission proposed changes to some of its penalties and corporate entities, the regulation of home heating oil contractors, and the prescribing of steroids.

The Board was advised that there is still time to have these proposals submitted privately, such as through the professional organizations and the Board members local legislators.
