683rd Session Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors January 23, 2007

The scheduled meeting of January 23, 2007 was held at the Board Office, 165 Capitol Avenue, Room 119 in the State Office Building, Hartford, Connecticut.

Anthony L D'Andrea, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:45 am.

Attending the meeting were John DeWolf (1) PE, John Hallisey (2) PE, Terry McCarthy (3) PE, Anthony L D'Andrea (4) PELS, Robert L Doane (5) PELS, Rocco V Laraia (8) PM, Curtiss B Smith (11) LS and Robert W Grossenbacher (12).

Absent was: William O Giel (10) LS.

There are three vacancies on the Board.

Also present were Steven Schwane, attorney for the Department of Consumer Protection, Peter Huntsman, Asst. Attorney General and Barbara Syp-Maziarz, Board Administrator.

Mr. Grossenbacher was excused at 11:00 am

Mr. Smith was excused at 11:00 am

Chairman D'Andrea congratulated Curtiss Smith for being designated as Surveyor of the year by the Connecticut Association of Land Surveyors (CALS).

Motion made by (8) seconded by (2) to accept the minutes of October 17, 2006 as amended. Motion carried.

Motion made by (2) seconded by (1) to accept the minutes of November 14, 2006 as amended. Motion carried.

Legal Division

Legislative Proposal: John Hallisey stated that he along with Anthony D'Andrea and Robert Dahn met with Senator Colapietro. They gave Senator Colapietro a copy of the current model law from NCEES, along with the copy of the current legislative changes and explained, what the Board was trying to do, and how long the Board has been pushing to get this legislation through.

Robert Dahn stated that he met with Chris Stone, who is willing to introduce the legislation in committee and if this does not happen, then the Board should be prepared to speak at the public hearing.

Atty. Schwane stated that as a follow up to the discussion held at the November 2006 PELS meeting, Atty. Schwane looked into the matter, of whether or not retired engineers would qualify as public members in the statutes. Atty. Schwane stated that in his opinion the retired engineers did not qualify and that public members should not have a direct connection with either profession. Chairman D'Andrea stated that the CSPE should still forward a list of names and let the governor's office make the decision.

Atty. Schwane gave an update to the proposed regulations of filing of maps in town records by the State Library. Atty. Schwane stated that he has not seen a publication in the law journal, but once there is any public hearing or notice, he will advise the Board.

Asst. Atty. Huntsman began the discussion that an engineer may not ignore a request by a building official for submission of certification in a particular form, and that the building official has the right to ask for the information.

The Board does not find that the requirements of individual towns to require forms for certification of inspections to be the practice of engineering. The forms are simply a means to provide a summary of what the engineer observed.

Mr. DeWolf will forward a letter to Mr. Isidro Cloudas advising him that based on the Board's discussion, this does not fall in the purview of the Board.

Re: Connecticut's Department of Environmental Protections revision to the General Permit for the Discharge of Groundwater Remediation Wastewater to a Sanitary Sewer to allow certification by a Professional Engineer, a Certified Hazardous Materials Manager or Licensed Environmental Professional. (Dist. 2)

A memorandum from Woodard & Curran dated August 25, 2006, initiated discussion on a letter from CSPE about whether or not a Licensed Environmental Professional or Hazardous Materials Manager should be allowed to confirm that the conditions of the permit were complied with.

Chairman D'Andrea stated that the Board has discussed numerous times, that the establishment of the specification is purview of an engineer. The state regulations allow for a professional engineer, licensed environmental professional or hazardous materials manager to confirm whether or not the project was in compliance with the conditions of the permit. The engineering was done when the design was prepared.

The Board does not feel that certification of compliance with permit conditions by licensed professionals is in conflict with Chapter 391 of the General Statutes.

D-New Business

D-1 –Review of Board's Policy in regards to those applicants applying for the Fundamentals of Engineering and Principles & Practice of Engineering Exams who hold foreign undergraduate degrees. ECEI is no longer available to candidates. (Dist. 2)

Policy of Board regarding holders of postgraduate and foreign undergraduate degrees:

1) In reviewing applications of those applicants who hold masters degrees, the Board noted Section 20-300-3 (a) Professional Engineer which states: "When an advanced degree in engineering has been awarded at an approved institution, education in residence may be considered as part of the experience requirement...". The Board interprets in residence as being enrolled in school full time.

The Board interprets this section, the way that it is written and literally taken, that if a candidate completes a masters program, immediately after a bachelors and went to work for three years, the individual would be given one (1) year credit. The applicant who works on his masters degree part time would not be granted the one (1) year credit.

The Board feels the issue of not giving credit for part time should be addressed in future discussions with a possible policy change in regard to the issue.

2) The Board will require evaluations for all foreign undergraduate degrees from an evaluation service approved by the Board except when an applicant holds a US Masters when applying for the first exam (Fundamentals of Engineering).

Professional Engineer Application

- a) With a US masters from a school with an ABET approved undergraduate curriculum, the individual may be considered under Class 1.
- b) Without a US masters from a school with an ABET approved engineering curriculum, the individual shall be considered under Class 2.

Engineer-In-Training Application

- c) With a US masters from a school with an ABET approved undergraduate curriculum, the individual may be considered under Class 9.
- d) Without a US masters from a school with an ABET approved engineering curriculum program, the individual shall be considered under Class 10.
- e) An individual with a foreign degree, which has been evaluated as equivalent, may be eligible for the EIT under Class 9.
