695th Session Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors October 14, 2008

The land surveyor members were dismissed at 10:30 am.

Motion made by (5) seconded by (8) to accept the minutes of July 15, 2008 with minor revisions. Motion carried.

Motion made by (5) seconded by (1) to accept the minutes of August 12, 2008. Motion carried.

CHRO- Applications-None

Legal Division- Updates

Legislative Proposal- Attorney Steven Schwane stated that he has had numerous conversations with Gary Berner, the Department's new legislative liaison regarding the Board's proposed legislation. Atty. Schwane was advised that the Board should not expect it to be part of the Department's package and should try to submit their legislative proposal on their own through their private professional associations. The Board stated that they are very disappointed that this has been going on for ten years and have agreed to continue to adopt policies that coincide with the National Model Law and continue to enforce them.

Update on the land surveyor licensed in Pennsylvania doing work in Connecticut-Atty. Schwane contacted the Pennsylvania Board and was advised that the PA Board is taking action against the land surveyor. Atty. Schwane stated that he provided the Pennsylvania Board with information that he had.

State Library-Legislative proposals regarding filing maps; this process is still ongoing.

C-1 Corporation Table-Revision of table based on advice from the Board's counsel that the joint practice of arch/engineering and land surveying is not an entity that is licensed by the Board. –Tabled from 2/19/08 and 4/29/08 Board meetings for revisions to be made by Assistant Attorney General Peter Huntsman.

Tabled to next meeting.

C-2 Update regarding citizenship and or legal status of future applicants.

The following are excerpts from the Board's minutes in regards to this issue

February 19, 2008 Minutes- "The Connecticut Board has been receiving numerous applications from the state of New York, where these applicants have been approved to sit for the national exams, but are not granted licenses based on citizenship or legal status. These applicants then apply to the state of Connecticut to obtain their initial licenses. The Board has received an informal opinion from the Board's legal counsel but is seeking a formal opinion as to whether or not the Board is doing something wrong in not asking for legal status in this country, or is the Board accepting some kind of liability. A formal opinion from the Attorney General's office will provide guidance to the Board, for approving these applications and in revising the current license application by requesting additional information concerning legal status and/or applying in other jurisdictions.

The Board is requesting that the Commissioner of Consumer Protection request the Attorney General's office for a formal opinion as to what this Board should require as to legal status of an applicant for consideration for licensure.

Assistant Attorney General Peter Huntsman stated that he presented an informal opinion at the November 27, 2007 meeting. Mr. Huntsman advised the Board that they have two avenues in requesting an opinion regarding legal status; the Board may request the informal opinion from November 27, 2007 in writing or request the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to request a formal opinion from the Attorney General's office

Assistant Attorney General Peter Huntsman stated that according to the statutes, the commissioner has the authority to create the application form and ask whatever questions deemed appropriate.

Chairman D'Andrea stated that he had a conversation with Janet Blair, Executive Secretary for the New York Board, who verified that their applicants are allowed to sit for the examinations but are denied the actual issuance of the licenses if they do not have legal status.

Motion made by (2) and seconded by (1) for the Board to request the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to request a formal opinion from the Attorney General's office as to how the Board should approach legal status of an applicant for consideration for licensure. Motion carried.

Motion made by (2) and seconded by (1) to table any applications regarding legal status. Motion carried."

April 29, 2008 Minutes- "Status of formal opinion from the Attorney General's office regarding citizenship/legal status-

Chairman D'Andrea stated that he signed a formal request for a formal written opinion that will be forwarded to the Attorney General's office."

<u>June 10, 2008 minutes</u>- Assistant Attorney General Peter Huntsman, stated that his office received the Board's official request and advised that obtaining a written formal opinion is a lengthy process and could take from one to two years.

The Board held a lengthy discussion in regards to the applications that are being submitted and have been tabled in regard to the formal opinion from the Attorney General. The Board proposed that they will seek permission from the Commissioner of Consumer Protection to add the question regarding legal status on the application and/or instruction sheet and in the interim will review those applications and advise those applicants of this requirement.

July 15, 2008- The Board forwarded a letter to those tabled applicants requesting why they chose Connecticut as the jurisdiction to apply for their first exam.

<u>August 12, 2008-</u> The Board reviewed the responses from the applicants and is requesting a clarification of their jurisdiction and authority to act on these applications from legal, therefore the Board voted to table any consideration of these application until the scheduled meeting in October.

Tabled for advice from the Board's legal counsel.
