721st Session Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors February 21, 2012

The rescheduled meeting of February 21, 2012, was held at the Board Office, 165 Capitol Avenue, Room 117 in the State Office Building, Hartford, Connecticut.

Anthony L D'Andrea, Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:25 am.

Attending the meeting were John DeWolf (1) PE, Terry McCarthy (3) PE, Anthony L D'Andrea (4) PELS, Al Regina (7) PM, T. Mark Barbieri (9) PM.

There was a moment of silence for William O Giel who passed away on January 25, 2012.

The following land surveyor members were excused because there was no land surveying business; Curtiss B Smith (11) LS and Robert W Grossenbacher (12) LS.

Absent were John Hallisey (2) PE, Robert L Doane (5) PELS Donald J Poland (6) PM and Rocco V Laraia (8) PM.

Also present were Steven Schwane, attorney for the Department of Consumer Protection, Barbara Syp-Maziarz, Board Administrator and Peter Huntsman, Assistant Attorney General.

Minutes- Motion made by (9) seconded by (7) to approve the January 2012 minutes as amended. Motion carried.

Legal Division

Attorney Steven Schwane attended a meeting at DEEP regarding the General Permit for Storm Water Pollution Control Plans. The big issue was whether certain unlicensed individuals could prepare the plans or certify the plans under this general permit. This is one area that the landscape architect would have more of a concern.

Vince McDermott, Chairman of the Landscape Architect Board as well as different individuals from the professional societies for engineers and land surveyors attended this meeting. Those groups raised their concern that only certain licensed professionals should prepare and certify the plans.

Atty. Schwane received an e-mail from Chris Stone (DEEP) stating that a consensus among meeting participants was that only Connecticut licensed professionals (PE & LA) shall certify the plan review. DEEP will consider the revision of the review certification to allow only PE or LA certification for non-engineered measures and only PE certification for engineered measures.

The DEEP will work to incorporate the changes and try to have this General Permit ready for October.

Atty. Schwane stated the Home Builders Association put in a proposed public bill for storm water professional, which would allow a license by DEEP to individuals who are not necessarily engineers or landscape architects. Gary Berner, the department's legislative liaison has not seen this proposed bill on the list of proposed bills. Chairman D'Andrea stated that the Board is opposed to this bill.
