748th Session Board of Examiners for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors August 18, 2015

Motion made by (7) seconded by (2) to approve the July 21, 2015 minutes as amended. Motion carried with two abstentions (5) and (7).

A-Correspondence Received

A-1 Email from Brian Boggess dated 8/11/15. Re: Engineering Consulting-Civil litigation. Question: Does the Board require that any engineer testifying in a civil litigation matter be licensed in your state, or could an out-of- state licensed engineer be permitted to testify in a Connecticut court without being in conflict with Board rules. (Dist. 2)

Chairman D'Andrea stated that the Board held this discussion about 3 or 5 years ago and came to the conclusion that ultimately it is up to the court to decide whether or not the engineer qualifies for the testimony. The chairman's opinion is that the individual is not testifying as an engineer but as an expert in the field. Therefore, you do not necessarily have to be licensed in the field that you are expert in.

Therefore, the opinion of the Board is that one does not need to be licensed in Connecticut to be qualified as an expert witness, however it is ultimately the decision of the court.

Motion made by (5) and seconded by (9) to accept the response that it is the opinion of the Board that one is not required to be licensed in Connecticut to qualify as an expert witness, however, the ultimate decision would rest with the court. Motion carried.

D-New Business

D-1 Draft submitted by the Chair of the Board of Landscape Architects. Re: Preparation of Site Plans by Licensed Landscape Architects. The Landscape Architect Board is looking for any comments or edits to the draft before the draft is submitted to the Department of Consumer Protection for approval. (Dist. 4)

Chairman D'Andrea stated that the Landscape Architect Board drafted a letter that alleges certain towns have refused landscape architects to present an application as the lead professional where the landscape architects are licensed in this analysis. It has been the consensus of the Board that any land use professional may be the lead on any application to a municipality or any other reviewing agency; ultimately the licensed professional is responsible for all the consultants.

The Board noted that the Board forwarded a similar letter to the city of Hartford on an individual matter.

The Board reviewed the draft submitted by the Landscape Architect Board and had no additional comments or edits to forward to the Landscape Architect Board.

Motion made by (9) seconded by (5) to issue no response to the draft.
