NEW BUSINESS

1. The Board discussed the (R-6) Accessibility Journeyman apprenticeship program, which can be set-up by any employer or the Connecticut Department of Labor with cooperation of the Connecticut Department of Education.

The Board discussed problems with all contractors performing (R-5) Accessibility Contractor and (R-6) Accessibility Journeyman related work and not registering any person to date as an apprentice with the Connecticut Department of Labor.

Note: The Elevator Work Examining Board had previously issued “Helpers” related cards to persons that were employed by an (R-5) Accessibility Contractor in the past. The Connecticut Department of Labor had announced that it would set-up an (R-6) Accessibility Journeyman program when an (R-5) Accessibility Contractor presents themselves to them. Currently, there are apprentices registered for the (R-2) Unlimited Journeyman program.

2. The Board discussed the process of the testing vendor processing applications. The Board voted to send a letter to DCP Commissioner concerning their concerns. Board member Thomas J. O’Reilly and Sally Katz abstained.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
