New Automobile Warranties Account Surcharge

(surcharge return on the sale or lease of new motor vehicles)

- A new automobile warranties account surcharge of \$3.00 per vehicle is imposed on the sale or lease of each new motor vehicle registered as a passenger vehicle, a passenger and commercial vehicle (combination) or a motorcycle. This includes vehicles registered in any other state as well as Connecticut.
- Please note, the law has changed and any surcharge paid after March 31st will be subject to a \$2.00 per vehicle late fee.

Pay the Surcharge Online: To pay the surcharge online, go to our website at www.elicense.ct.gov to access your account with your User ID and Password. If necessary, you may click “Forgot Password” at the online website to reset. Questions or issues with accessing your account can be emailed to dcp.online@ct.gov. Once you have completed the login process, click “Renewal” under Online Services to begin.

Notification of Surcharge Payment Date Change: Beginning in 2023, the New Automobile Warranties Account Surcharge will change to an annual lump sum payment based on all new motor vehicles sold or leased during the prior calendar year of January 1st to December 31st and will be due by March 31st. This will take effect after payment is submitted for this current reporting period. The Department of Consumer Protection will send notifications in early 2023 for payment of the annual surcharges for new motor vehicles sold or leased in 2022. Please keep your email information with our office current to receive notifications.
