Re: Provider Assistance

DDS continues to work on strengthening our qualified provider community to meet the growing demand for waivered services. Maintaining high standards while expanding the qualified provider network benefits individuals through increased choice of provider, service and location.

To ensure that DDS has quality new providers, there are times when new applicant agencies may need assistance from current providers who are willing to help support them through the application process. In addition, current Qualified Providers may look to expand their menu of DDS services, while benefiting from a more experienced provider with real world experience.

DDS often has these providers reach out to the Qualified Providers list on our website for mentoring opportunities. However, "cold calling" agencies without knowing who to contact, or knowing if they are willing or able to assist is inefficient and not always successful.

In order to ensure the best outcomes, DDS will consider adding providers who have at least 3 years of DDS experience and that have not been on Enhanced Monitoring or had significant quality concerns in the past year.
