**Subject:** Subcontracted Nursing Agency Qualifications Update

The Department of Developmental Services (DDS) has updated the Qualifications for Subcontracting Nursing Consultant Agencies to follow when hired by a DDS Qualified Provider and/or working with any individual receiving DDS funding. There are a few minor changes to the timing of some required trainings (in # 11) as follows:

- Sexual Harassment is required every 10 (ten) years.
- Safe Swallowing is required every 2 (two) years.
- OSHA/Universal Precautions is required every 2 (two) years.

Please note that qualified providers shall only subcontract with nursing agencies that are deemed qualified nurse consulting agencies by DDS.
