## **Threshold Requirements**

- The **Affordable Housing Policy** (effective from July 20, 2022)
  - o Covers the grant and loan remediation programs
  - o All associated redevelopment projects proposing 10 or more units have to comply
  - o A portion of those units must be deed-restricted for 30 years
  - o For more details, see the Notice of Funding Availability or FAQs

- Renewable energy and clean Hydrogen production
  - o fuel cell installation
  - o energy storage
- Climate change, resiliency, sustainability
  - Green building design
  - Resiliency features

## **Grant Request Upper Limit**

• Upper Limit for a grant request has been increased to \$4 million
