
This document includes the photographs from the William Pinto House NRHP nomination form along with modern photographs that show, where possible, similar views of the house. The photos were taken January 15, 2020. Captions on the modern photographs use the text from the historic photographs so that the it is clear which photographs are related to each other. The numbering for the modern photographs also ties them to the historic photos; they have the same number with the addition of the letter A. For historic photographs that show features no longer present, a place holder page is included with an explanation of why the image is different or missing. The plan from the NRHP nomination, an annotated first-floor plan from the 1964 HABS drawings of the building, is also included. (There is no second-floor plan in the HABS documentation.) Although the use of cardinal directions appears to be somewhat inconsistent these inconsistencies were repeated in the captions of the modern photographs so as not to add confusion.




