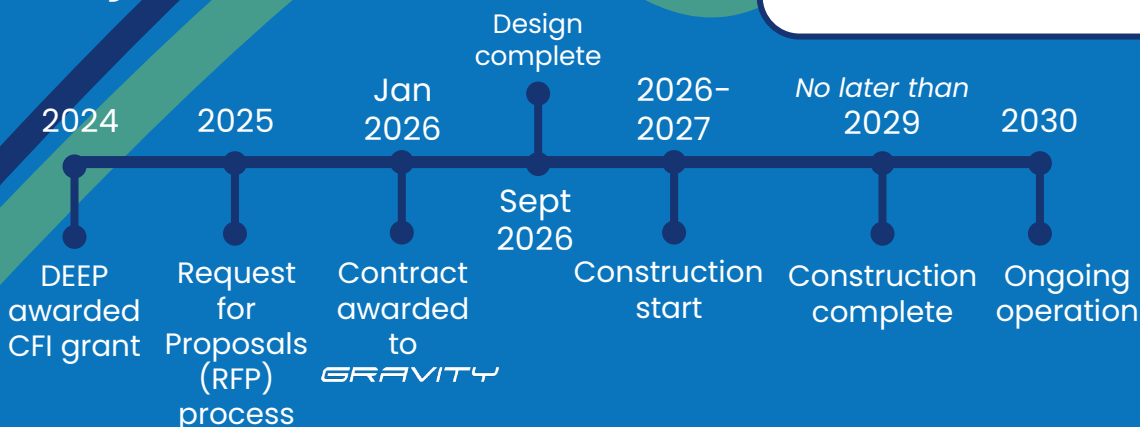

Project Timeline

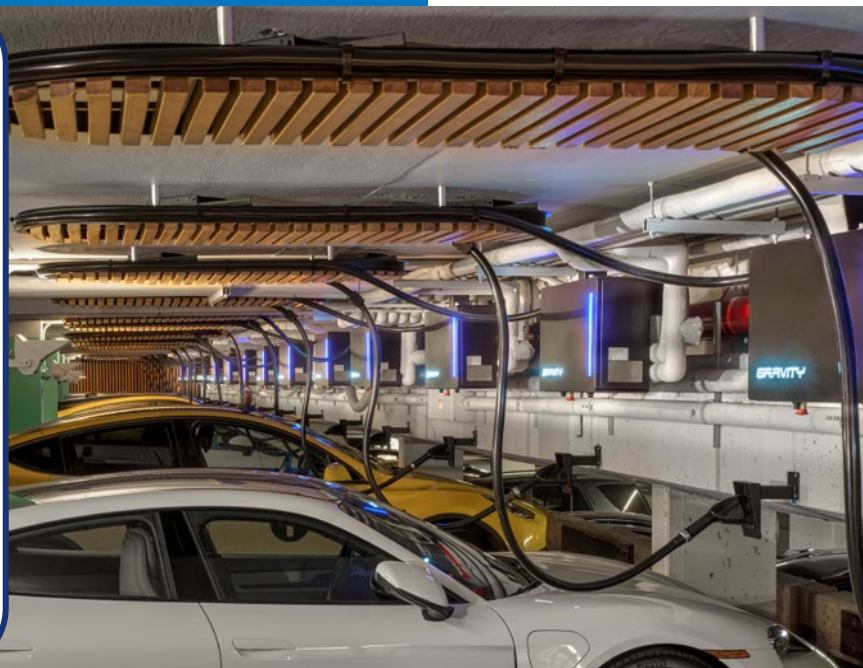


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The CFI Program is a grant program created by the **Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA)**. CFI provides funding to strategically deploy **publicly accessible electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure**.



Benefits of increasing fast charging infrastructure through the CFI Grant include:

- **Easier access** to EV charging, especially in rural and low-income areas and areas impacted by air pollution
- **Faster charging** times with DCFC equipment
- Support EV adoption to **reduce tailpipe pollution and improve air quality**
