Thank you for your letter of September 27, 2001 requesting approval of Portland's Noise Control Ordinance.

Based on review of the ordinance (copy attached) it has been determined that the ordinance conforms with state noise control standards. The Commissioner of Environmental Protection has delegated the authority (with respect to Connecticut General Statutes Chapters 446a and 446c) to approve local noise ordinances to the Chief of the Bureau of Air Management. Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 22a-73(c), I approve Portland's Noise Control Ordinance as approved by the Town of Portland on September 26, 2001.
