

Certification of Public Review Process

This certifies in accordance with the provisions of Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 51.102 that the following actions were taken by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) regarding the Limited Maintenance Plan for the Southwest Connecticut PM2.5 Maintenance Area.

- 1) The public notice was published on DEEP's website on January 11, 2023. The notice provided opportunity to submit written comments through February 22, 2023.
- 2) DEEP's notice indicated that a hearing would be held on February 22, 2023, only if a request for a hearing was received on or before February 15, 2023. No hearing request was received so the public hearing was cancelled. The cancellation was posted on DEEP's website.
- Materials were available for review upon request and posted on DEEP's website.
- 4) On January 11, 2023, notice was emailed to the directors of air pollution control agencies of New York, New Jersey, Rhode Island and Massachusetts, as well as Region I of the Environmental Protection Agency.
- 5) On February 9, 2023, a presentation was made to the State Implementation Plan Revision Advisory Committee notifying them of the proposed SIP revision and opportunity for hearing and comment.
