Application Period Closes on December 8, 2015

DEEP is offering a competitive funding opportunity for municipalities and statemencies to purchase EVs and/or to purchase and install EV charging stations at municipal state agency facilities.

Utilizing funds made available through the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI). DEEP will provide a reimbursement of up to \$15,000 per vehicle and up to \$10,000 per charger meeting the program guidance specifications, with a maximum of six EVs and chargers per grant recipient.

The overall goal for this program is to promote EV use by increasing the number of EVs in public fleets and by establishing more EV charging stations throughout Connecticut, DEEP will consider the cost effectiveness, the potential for timely completion and operation, and the overall economic benefits to Connecticut when selecting proposals for awards.
