- Agencies have the choice to make comments available for viewing in the system.
 - If not published in the system, comments must be included in the comment-and-response document (aka, the hearing



Source of Current Regulations

- Search function
- Browse function
- Both functions provide current regulations updated to a specific date.
 - Regulatory history provided at the end of each section.
 - Regulation Making Records available for sections processed originally through eRegulations.
