






Regulatory Update Proposed Amendment to sections 22a-174-1 and 22a-174-3a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies

Presentation Overview





Introduction

In an effort to reduce the regulatory burden on small incinerators; RCSA sections 22a-174-1 and 22a-174-3a are being amended.

Purpose: To exempt burn-off ovens and other types of incinerators from the requirement to apply for and obtain a permit under RCSA section 22a-174-3a. **Proposal Highlights**

- Five new categories of incinerators to be exempted.
- With potential emissions of less than 15 tons per year, except for the air curtain incinerator category.



Does not address crematories.

RCSA §22a-174-3a(a)(1)(G)(iii) Burn-off Oven

A device that is used to remove residual amounts of coating, varnish, resin, or other organic material from metal parts or surfaces by the application of fire or heat; provided that such device is:

- An indirect-fired unit;
- Equipped with a secondary chamber or afterburner that operates at a minimum temperature of 1400°F; and
- Operated and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and written recommendations.






RCSA §22a-174-3a(a)(1)(G)(iv) Bench Scale R&D

An incinerator used for bench scale research and development (R&D) operations, as that term is defined in RCSA §22a-174-33(a)(8).

RCSA §22a-174-3a(a)(1)(G)(v) QC or Performance Testing

An incinerator used to burn samples of nonhalogenated materials for the purpose of conducting quality control (QC) or <u>per</u>formance testing.







RCSA §22a-174-3a(a)(1)(G)(vi) Contraband or Confiscated Goods

An incinerator used as a portable unit to destroy contraband or confiscated goods, and the unit is owned or operated by a government agency such as police, customs, or a similar agency.







RCSA §22a-174-3a(a)(2)(B)(vi) Air Curtain Incinerators

An "air curtain incinerator," provided that such unit is operated by a town or municipality that has been issued an open burning permit by the commissioner.





RCSA §22a-174-1 Definitions
